

General Information

Capacity: Resident Camps will be **limited to 150 campers**.

No Walk-ups: For late registrations, please call to see if space is available.

Some sessions of camp fill quickly. When **capacity is reached, registration closes.** The camp offers more than one choice for most age groups. While registering by the Early-Bird deadline does not guarantee your child's place in a particular session of camp, the likelihood of getting your first choice is greatly increased.

Grade: Restrictions are enforced based on the grade campers are **entering** in the fall of next year.

Written permission: is required to participate in day trips.

First-aid staff is on duty during youth camps. If you desire the strictest confidentiality of your camper's **Personal Health Information (P.H.I.)**, please mail it separately with **Attn: Nurse** on the envelope.

Medicine: The nurse will keep and dispense all medicine. All medication must be in original container and have written instructions.

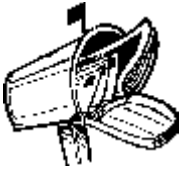
Pictures may be taken for promotional use.
