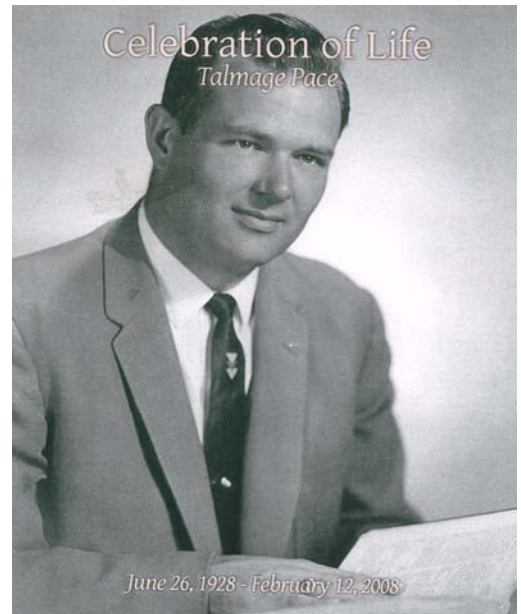
Remembering Talmage...
